



The 2010 National Jamboree

Fort A.P. Hill, Caroline County, Virginia

July 26 - August 4, 2010

The Theodore Roosevelt Council will take a contingent of
3 troops with 36 youth and 4 adult leaders in each Troop.

Qualifications for Scouts:

- Be at least a **First Class Boy Scout** at the time of attendance at the Jamboree.
- Have completed the sixth grade or be at least **12 years of age by July 1, 2010** and have not yet reached his 18th birthday by August 2, 2010.
- Be approved by his Scoutmaster and the local council jamboree committee.
- Participate in the council pre-jamboree training experience.
- Submit a Jamboree Medical Form.

Qualifications for Scouters (Adults):

- Be physically fit [there is a great deal of walking; it was very hot and humid in 2005.]
- Be a registered Scouter and trained in your position.
- To be a Scoutmaster or First ASM you must have served as a Scoutmaster for one year during the three-year period prior to the start of the 2010 National Jamboree.
- Be approved by the local council jamboree committee
- Participate in the pre-jamboree training experience.
- Submit a Jamboree Medical Form.



Financial Details:

Reserve your place now to receive a National Jamboree application when they are issued by downloading the form online at www.trcbsa.org/Jamboree/2010Jamboree.htm and send it to the council service center.

The trip has an estimated cost of **\$1500 - \$2000*** which includes transportation, meals, lodging, special patches, hat, T-shirt, all Patrol and Troop equipment, a training weekend and a sight seeing trip visiting historical landmarks. Final payment is due in December 2009.
